Ambition Raising - NDC updates and a new agreement

2020 setting the scene for the Paris Agreement and the Convention on Biological Diversity

Paris Agreement

- 1st Revision Process
- Need for enhanced ambition
- More than 100 countries announced updates, some to be more ambitious
- EU: discussion ongoing to raise emission reduction target to 55%

A post-2020 global biodiversity framework

- Urgent need for transformative change
- Ambitious conservation targets
- Address the drivers of biodiversity loss
- Focus on implementation



IKI and NDC enhancement

NDC Partnership


- 65 COUNTRIES to receive support for NDC enhancement and implementation.
- 40 PARTNERS providing technical support
- 7 DONORS contributing to TAF and CAEP
- 755 ACTIVITIES to be supported
- Total support of \$34,486,912

UNDP Climate Promise

- Aim: Support of 100+ countries
- IKI' share:
 - More than 40 Mio. EUR for the NDC UNDP NDC Support Programme
 - New 20 Mio. EUR Fund jointly with UNDP and FAO focussing on agriculture and land use




IKI: Facts and figures since 2008

IKI's Funding Selection Procedures

for climate & biodiversity programmes in developing & emerging countries with different thematic and geographical prioritisations

LARGE-SCALE PROJECTS

- Larger funding volume (5 20 million EUR)*
- Longer programme duration (up to max. 8 years)*
- implemented by a consortium (+2 implementing organisations)

Thematic Calls Calls Calls



SMALL-SCALE PROJECTS

- Smaller funding volume (up to 800.000 EUR)*
- Shorter project duration (up to 3 years)*
- implemented by individual organisations



IKI Main Partner Countries




IKI is essential for our bilateral cooperation
